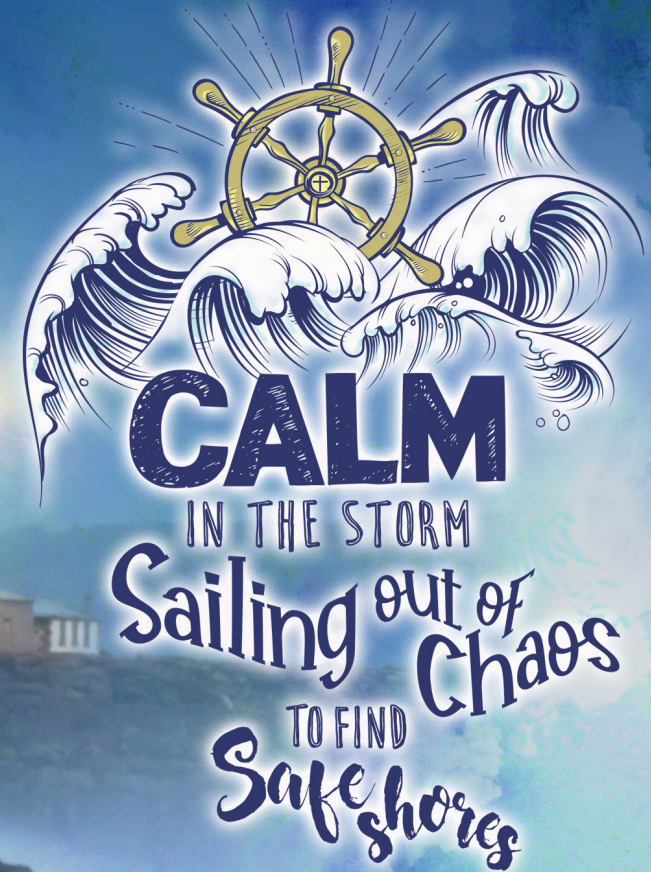

OVERVIEW:

What is the Five-Day Academy®?

The Five-Day Academy for Spiritual Formation is a program of The Upper Room®, providing an opportunity for clergy and laity to tune their hearts toward God through a daily rhythm of prayer, worship, learning and reflection. Each day includes teachings by gifted spiritual leaders to deepen our walk with God, periods of silence, morning and evening prayer, Eucharist, and an opportunity to share with and encourage one another.

When and where will the academy be held?

WHEN:

Arrival on Sunday, April 24, 2022, 3 - 5 p.m.
Conclusion on Friday, April 29, 2022 at 1 p.m.

Does the Five Day Academy® qualify for continuing education credit?

YES. If you choose to seek credit, you will be provided with the necessary form to be signed by the faculty. The form must then be submitted to the leadership team with a \$15 payment at the conclusion of the event. A commitment to full-time participation by all participants is expected.

What does it cost?

If you register before February 15, 2022 the cost is \$675 per person, which includes tuition, private room and bath, and all meals. Registration cost after that date is \$700 per person. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration. All registrations and payments are due by April 1. Clergy and laity may qualify for limited scholarship funds.
